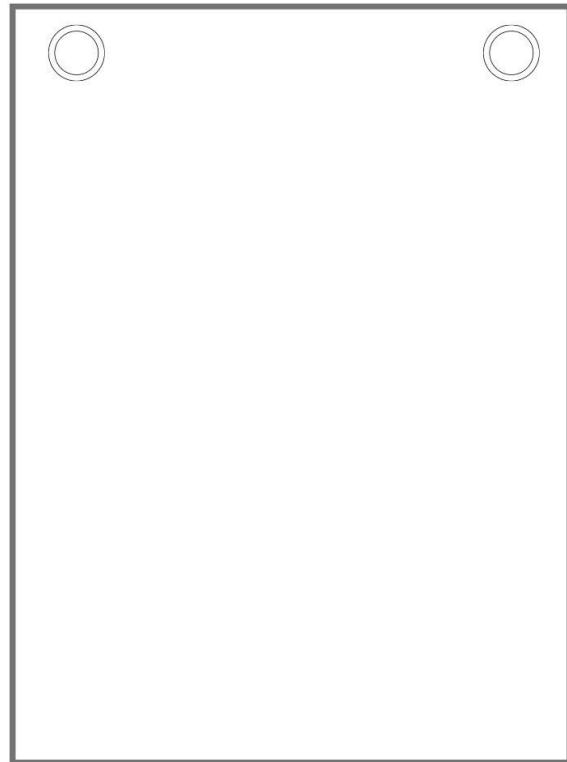

## Community ART Project

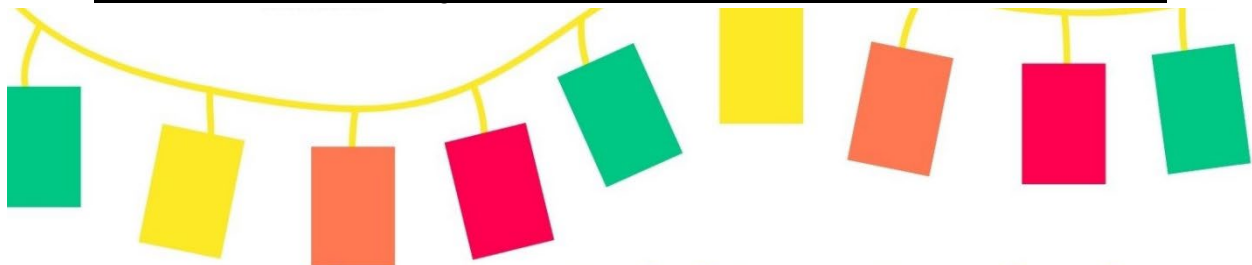
### *"Our Connection to Water"*

## Flag Painting Instructions/Guidelines:

- Artists must paint original designs (family-friendly, no copyrighted material, no religious or political propaganda).
- Designs must reflect the theme of “*our connection to water*”.
- Artists must use paint provided by SCAA or similar exterior acrylic paint.
- Artists must paint **BOTH** sides of each flag (can be two different designs).
- Artists may paint multiple flags (while supplies last).
- Artist must sign their work.
- Flags must be returned to SCAA no later than July 30, 2023.
